

Truwithiel

Truwithiel is the fertile, temperate land in the centre of the cold Continent of Peredur, surrounded mountains, and bounded by tall cliffs with three spectacular falls. Its main river drains north into a huge bogland ending in a deep ravine, which eventually gives rise to an underground river.

The land is made up of various counties overseen by the main towns, but the whole region is under the Lord Mayor sitting in the capital of Polwenna on Lake Trudennis. This lake is a world wonder, being one giant warm pool fed by volcanic heat below. One day, perhaps, it will erupt, but no time soon. This is the main factor in keeping the land relatively warm, but also results in near continual cloud cover, also adding to the heat.

Truwithiel's major industries are mining and farming. The land as a whole is self sufficient – it has to be because of its isolation. There are few passes to the lands beyond, and not so safe.

The land itself, and the surrounding heights are dotted with ruined towers, bogs, moors, humanoid settlements, stone circles and the like.
