

Runcibor region

This area is dominated by farming to the north east and north west, the latter centred on the village of Runcibor. A large, almost self-contained Inn, the Inn of the Drunken Bear, lies in the north east, and serves not only the local community, but also those hardy pilgrims to the hidden lands of Skorra. Between these 2 regions lies the Wolfenvoger Woods, reputedly the home of vicious werewolves and worse. The road that bisects them is always travelled by day, and in largish groups for safety.

To the south are the mountains, the peaks of Falkeherz, Zaubereig and Bergprinz dominating. There lie the ruins of an old keep of the extinct family of Nieckarz, now the haunt of undead.

Further south are elvish and orcish communities, continually warring with each other. Somewhere in the mountains is reputed to be a deep still lake with prehistoric stone monuments – no one remembers what lies there.

A huge monument, carved from the hillside lies near the elven territory, supposedly the father of their Clan, Lord Grausam, who is rumoured to be buried with much treasure at the monument's base. Needless to say, would be treasure plunderers have met a grisly fate at the hand of the elves, and the heads of the would be looters are impaled on pikes near the monument.

Finally, in the mid-east sit two giant monoliths, the Mutigtoter Tors, venerated by the forgotten primitive people who once inhabited these parts.
